

“My Heartfelt Service”
(Sermon Questions for Life Groups: January 21th, 2018)

Ice Breaker: What ministries have you been involved in that God has used to shape your lives? In what way did they grow you as a Christian?

Read Together: Read John 13:12-20

1. Is Christ teaching that foot washing should be practiced today? (v. 12) Feel free to look at what took place in the object lesson in verses 1-11.
2. What is Christ asking his 12 Disciples? (v. 12)
3. Did Christ model the role of a typical Teacher or as their Lord? (v. 13)
4. According to verses 14-15, what will this look like for the disciples to wash each other's feet? How could this be lived out in all Christian's lives?
5. What type of attitude is Christ striving to teach to His disciples about being a servant?
6. Knowing that Jesus Christ, the Son of God and the Savior of the world, took this humble, loving position~~what is our duty? (v. 15)
7. Christ had just demonstrated great humility as the Master and Sender of the disciples. What implication is He making in verse 16?
8. The way to blessedness as God's people is to live a life of humble servanthood to all mankind. Are there limits to servanthood? When is enough service enough? What pattern did Christ give (Philippians 2:8)?
9. Do you believe that Christ would consider much of our service to Him as genuine service if we only serve when it is convenient and on our terms?

Application: *Things to ask ourselves....*

1. Where are we currently sacrificially serving others today in Christ's church and in our daily lives?
2. Is there a way that we as a life group can reach out to those immediately around us and share Christ-like love?
