FOCUS POINTS

- W Exalting the Living God** by attending h₂o and worshipping with parents or peers.
- I Explaining the Word of God** in Sunday morning Life Groups (*B.R.I.C.K.: Built Right in Christ’s Kingdom*) and weekly h₂o meeting.
- S Encouraging the Family of God** through fellowship with Christian peers at weekly h₂o Large Group Meeting and spring/summer service Projects.
- E Extending the Love of God** by learning to share and live the Great Commandment, the Great Commission and doing acts of kindness.

MEASURABLE OBJECTIVES

- Students follow Christ by being baptized.
- Students learn how to study, interpret, and apply Scripture to his/her own lives.
- Students know how to grow in his/her faith in Christ.
- Students participate in summer servant projects.
- Students/Parents meet together to learn what the Scripture teaches about morality and biblical sexuality.
- Students/Parents meet together to learn what Scripture teaches about family discipleship.
- Students can clearly articulate the Gospel to their peers
- Students participate in ongoing church/community service needs.

ANTICIPATED OUTCOMES

- Valuing being in God’s presence; listening to His voice, and living it out every day.
- Grasping the key doctrines and foundational truths of the Christian faith and growing in love with the Word of God.
- Learning how to overcome peer pressure through team work and developing an others-focused mentality at home and church.
